## Cleaning Specialist – Job Description

The Apple Hill Center for Chamber Music in Nelson, NH is looking for a seasonal, part-time Cleaning Specialist (CS) under the supervision of the Facilities Manager.

### Responsibilities:

- provide cleaning services for shower/bathroom facilities and common areas across campus
- clean flooring and fixtures
- remove trash and recycling

### Qualifications:

- Custodial or housekeeping experience preferred, but is not necessary; in-house training and all cleaning supplies will be provided
- Employee must be flexible with scheduling to include some peak busy times and one-time only assignments
- Usual work assignments require standing, walking, lifting, and possible exposure to all outside weather conditions
- Ability to use typical equipment associated with cleaning activities, including but not limited to mops, vacuums, and cleaning solutions
- Ability to work independently
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs
- Must have transportation

**Schedule:** The CS is an exempt, part-time employee. Up to 20hrs/week from June 12- August 28, with possibility for additional engagement in the fall. This is a flextime position with hours determined after discussions with the Facilities Manager but the majority of hours worked are in the morning.

**Compensation:** \$15-\$22/hr. Meals included when working on campus; summer housing on campus is negotiable.
